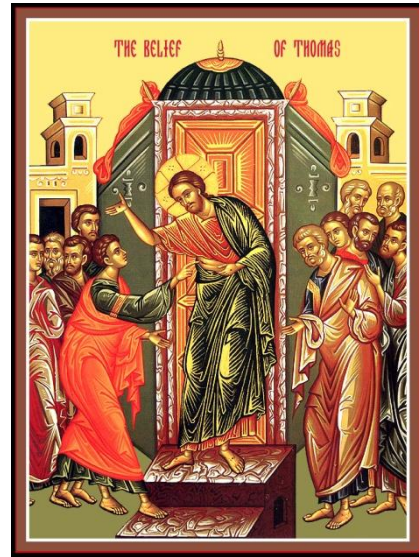

1. Photius, Patriarch of Constantinople, famous for his rebuking of the West in the matter of the Filioque, was a layman and theologian before he became Patriarch.
2. The College of the Bishops is the teacher of the faith to the whole church, while the people of God are the witness of tradition.
3. The Divine Liturgy (the Mass) holds the very first place in the worship of the East, as it does in the Catholic West. It is THE action in which the church most clearly reveals its nature; as the mystery of God in time, the body of Christ. In the sacred action of the Divine Liturgy Jesus Christ is revealed and made present among mankind.
