Dear Friends,

Did you know that:

1. The mystery of the Incarnation, God's coming among us as a man in Jesus Christ, governs the Eastern Church's attitude to the created world and to the nature of Christian worship in the world. When the church prays, most particularly in the Divine Liturgy, heaven and earth are in communion.
2. Saint Nicholas is almost certainly the most popular saint in the Christian East. Inexplicably his feast was demoted in the public calendar of the Roman Church in the 1960s, a declaration of little ecumenical delicacy.
3. Byzantium was the sleepy village chosen by the Emperor Constantine as the site for the new capital, Constantinople. Its name is given to describe East Roman civilization as a whole and to describe the marvelously rich worship that spread from Byzantium across the near East and into Eastern Europe.
