Dear Friends,

Did you know that:

1. Since the earliest days of the desert monastic communities, the Jesus prayer, in various forms, has been in use in the East. The prayer is “Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner.” It spread beyond the monasteries and penetrated into the daily lives of believers. It is one of Orthodoxy’s most popular prayer forms, suitable for mystics and beginners, for the monastic solitude or when waiting for the bus.
2. To be a Christian means to be a participant in the divine-human communion, which is engendered in the soul by the waters of baptism. The Jesus prayer is to be understood in this light. It calls upon Jesus, who himself is the divine-human communion.
3. There are a number of communities of Byzantine Rite. Christians who are in communion with the Roman See. Some never really left it, others returned, others were more or less invented by the Roman Church. They are most often called “Uniate” churches (Those in union). The two largest uniate churches are the Ukrainian Catholics and the Melkite Church of Antioch. Both churches have communities in most of the English-speaking countries.
