Dear Friends,  
Did you know that:

#### 1. Adam and Eve

God placed man and woman in the Garden of Eden; they were naked "And were not ashamed". (Gen 2:25). Then God warned that they might eat of every tree in the Garden but the Tree of Knowledge of good and evil. The consequence of eating from the Tree was death. Eve, however, at the prompting of the serpent, tasted its fruit and offered some to Adam. Then they "Knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves aprons." (Gen. 3:7).

After God discovered they had eaten from the Tree of Knowledge, he cursed them. Eve was named as the mother of all living, and after clothing them with garments of skin, God banished them from the Garden of Eden.

#### 2. Cain and Abel

The story of Adam and Eve's sons, Cain and Abel, is told in the fourth chapter of the Book of Genesis. Abel tended sheep while Cain tilled the ground, and both offered sacrifices to God, who responded by having "regard for Abel and his offering, but for Cain and his offering he had no regard." (Gen. 4:4-5).

Cain became angry. God rebuked him, saying that Cain must master the sin "Couching at the door." Cain responded by taking Abel into the fields and killing him. God then cursed Cain and "put a mark" on him. Then Cain went to live in the land of Nod, East of Eden.

- #### 3. The Seventh Ecumenical Council laying down that the Holy Icons and the Book of the Gospels should be venerated in the same way. In every Church the Gospel Book has a place of honor on the altar; it is carried in procession at the Liturgy and at Matins on Sundays and feasts.
