Protomartyr and Archdeacon St. Stephen
Feast day - Dec. 27, the 3rd day of Christmas

St. Stephen is one of seven deacons mentioned in the Book of Acts who was ordained by the Apostles (Acts 6:5-7). He was the first martyr of the Church. In the icon, St. Stephen carries the censer in his right hand and in his left hand he holds a church symbolic of that which he has been called to serve.

"You fought the good fight, First Martyr of Christ, and Apostle. You exposed the perversion of the persecutors for when you were killed by stones from the hands of wicked men, you received a crown from the Right Hand on High, and you cried out to God, saying 'O Lord, do not charge this sin against them.'" (Acts 7:59)
